We know everyone is busy these days, so this will be a slothful book club: each month, neighbors will read one section of the book individually, then come together as a group to discuss.



Voter Turnout

Armatage's voter turnout in the November election topped 90% of registered voters!

Turnout for Ward 13 Precinct 8, which includes the portion of Armatage north of 58th Street was **92.4%.** For Ward 13, Precinct 9, which includes all of Armatage

south of 58th Street, turnout was 91.5%.

Overall, citywide voter turnout was 81.3% of registered voters so well done, Armatatge! In a year with so many changes, thank you for everything you did to roll with it and spread the word!
