## Armatage Bylaws & Funding Plan

This fall, the ANA needs your help! The neighborhood will update its governing bylaws in order to comply with the City of Minneapolis's new funding program.

The ANA has also drafted a neighborhood Plan Modification to shift more funds from recently repaid home loans to its long-term community engagement and staffing budgets to enable the ANA to operate as long as possible.

We hope to have as many Armatage community members weigh in on

both before the ANA Board makes a final vote in October.


is now scheduled to drop to \$18,800 in 2022 and to just \$14,100 in 2023.
