
ANNUAL MEETING: GROWING TOGETHER TUES, MAY 17 | 6:30PM

Rain Garden **Program**

The Green Team is happy to announce that this year's Rain Garden Program received additional funding via the State of Minnesota's competitive Lawns to Legumes Neighborhood Demonstration grant program.

This matching grant allows us to help pollinators throughout our neighborhood while sharpening our focus on accessibility and equity.

Our goal is to help fund 10-12 residential pollinator and rain gardens, with priority given to seniors, renters, and low-income neighbors. All are welcome to apply. The subsidy and support will vary.
